- 8/. Bin Sheds and general appearance are to be discussed at an up-coming meeting between the RA, Golding, Hyde and FP representatives on the 24<sup>th</sup> January with a view to controlling fly tipping.
- 9/. It was felt that bin sheds are a potential fire hazard, and that smoke detectors should be installed.
