Right to Manage:

Right to Manage was discussed and a meeting will be set up with Richard Bould of Jennings & Barrett with Ray and Phil representing the Association for advice on procedure, and how to achieve this.

Ray is to write to Hyde Housing, and Golding Homes to introduce the Association for further contact.

Fly Tipping:

As the council only charge £50 to collect bulky items, First Port are to be approached so that the Association organises with the leasehold blocks collection on a monthly basis as required, and First Port to pay the council for this service.

Resident Car Stickers:

The committee is to try to find a more cost effective way of printing and registering these stickers.

Funding is to come from our projected “Fun Day” fund raising event. It was agreed that 2 stickers/dashboard permits would be issued to each household to identify residents’ vehicles to avoid issuing of parking fines by the CPM, as long as vehicles are not parked on yellow lines or on pathways.

Resident Stickers will be registered by household, and registration numbers added to our database. By doing this we can recruit more members, and also police our facebook page to restrict it to residents only.

First Port Meeting:

Set for mid-morning on the 14th June with Ben Williams and the new site manager. We will not give her a hard time as we need to work together for the benefit of the Leybourne Park development. Committee members are welcome to join Ray for this meeting.
