First Port £15000 progress

Ray reported that for the second year running First Port had used the £15000 designated from their management fees to reduce amount invoiced to residents in service charge instead of spending it on improvements to the estate despite the agreement that it would be available for site improvements nominated by the Committee. This year they have spent £13000 on improvements but this will fall to be charged to residents via their service charge.

Meeting with First Port and repeat of survey by E&M

This meeting will need to be held via zoom or similar and it was felt that this might encourage more residents to take part. Action: Ray to agree possible dates with First Port.

Composition of Committee

It has become clear that Committee structure etc is not clear to everyone and that there have been decisions made which are not readily accessible.
