Rupert suggested the boundary fence be changed into a hedge row which was agreed.

Ray suggested also a row of Poplars to add height alongside SIMS yard. To be discussed with Georgia on her next visit.

Anti-Social Behaviour – it was agreed this is not something that the RA can be involved in directly and residents should contact the police and their housing association.

Yellow Lining – with CPM not completing the free lining, the plans should be altered to minimize the costs to residents and complete the Bellingham Way entrance only.
