(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2024

Southern Water works.

To allow manhole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of New Hythe Lane, Larkfield.

A closure is planned from 12th March 2024, with estimated completion by 13th March 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT13103668-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

New Hythe Lane will be closed outside 432 New Hythe Lane, between the hours of 19:00 and 06:00 only. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce to allow manhole replacement works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Bellingham Way, College Road, Papyrus Way and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
